



Disciplinary Ruling

The WBU Law and Ethics committee was asked to consider an incident at the Graded Masters in Wrexham in December. It found that Richard Cross had behaved in a way that contravened Law 74 A2 of the game which reads "A player should carefully avoid any remark or action that might cause annoyance or embarrassment to another player or might interfere with the enjoyment of the game."

Richard Cross has been given a formal warning about his future conduct and this ruling will be notified to his home bridge union.

Poor conduct by some players in WBU events is compromising the enjoyment of others and should not be tolerated. It notes that more experienced players have a special responsibility in this area.
