Format

9 x 6 board round Howell each day (54 boards) on RealBridge

Time table for both days:

10:00 – Round 1

10:50 – Round 2

11:40 – Round 3

12: 30 – Round 4

Lunch break

14:00 Round 5

14:50 Round 6

15:40 Round 7

16:30 Round 8

17:20 Round 9

Finish 18:10

Scoring: On the day you will see cross-imp scores which will give you an indication of how well you are doing. However, with only four or five tables in play one strange/bizarre score on a board does have a significant effect on the scores. So, we will be using a set of hands from a previous high-class event which had significantly more tables so that we get a truer datum to compare with. Those results will be published separately and will be used to decide the winning pair.

Rules: Play will be with screens and written self-alerts and scored by imps. Delayed kibitzing of all tables will be available for spectators. The time allowed for a 6-board set is 50 minutes. The rules used over the weekend will be those employed in the Lady Milne weekend including any warnings or fines for slow play.
