# CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES 6th October 2023

The Silver Plate, open to all first and second-round losers (with the exception of Scottish teams), at no extra charge, is run by Bridge Great Britain. First and second round Scottish losers have free entry into the Marion Hill Trophy, which is administered by the Scottish Bridge

The Gold Cup is the most prestigious teams event in the British bridge calendar. Leading teams will be seeded. Matches in Round 1 are of 32 boards (though may be increased to 40 or 48 by prior arrangement between the two Captains).

# Silver Plate Holders (2022) David Robinson, Tony Sowter, Alan Hayward, Tony McNiff

The Silver Plate is administered by Bridge Great Britain, and your Gold Cup entry fee entitles you to play in the Silver Plate at no extra charge. The first round draw will be sent out 2-3 weeks after the closing date for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the Gold Cup. If you do <u>not</u> intend to play in the Silver Plate, please tick here.

#### Gold Cup Timetable 2024

The closing date for entries is Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

The early rounds of the Gold Cup will be regionalised. The default in the early rounds will be online, including cases requiring a half-way venue, and for matches from the round of 16 onwards, the default will be face-to-face. In the case of online, BBO will be the default but RealBridge an alternative if both teams agree, and the Committee will be the final arbiter in case of a dispute. It is strongly recommended that the default setting is for no kibitzers during online matches.

The closing date for Round 1 is 11th December, and for Round 2 19th February 2024.

The Semi-finals and Final will be played on 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> October 2024.
