Richard is a retired investment manager. He represented the British junior team in the 1980's and won the Gold Cup in 1988 before taking a twenty year break from bridge to pursue his investment career. Returning to bridge in 2013, he has represented Wales in every European Championship since then.

His partnership with Espen began during lockdown and they have enjoyed considerable success, winning the Spring Foursomes in 2023 and 2024, the European Winter Games in 2023 (and the BAM in the same tournament in 2024) and the Maarit International Pairs in Norway in 2023. Richard has also won the Tollemache, EBU Two Stars Pairs, Brighton Swiss Pairs and EBU National Point-a-Board teams (twice) since 2022.

Outside Bridge Richard lives with his fiancée Chloe and has two sons Mark and James. His mother Sally aged 90 still plays regularly at the Gwent Bridge Academy.
